Turn in a perpendicular direction from the first line and measure 4 units. Then, measure the diagonal between the ends of your 2 lines. If it measures 5 units, your corner is square. If it's less than 5 units, your corner is less than 90 degrees; if it's greater than 5 units, your corner angle is too large.

Choose the finished size for your Square in a Square quilt block or unit. Cut the center square fabric equal to the finished block size plus 1/2" (for seam allowances). Cut four corner patch fabrics equal to the finished size of the block divided by 2 and add 1/2" for seam allowances.

The most common way to make a photo square is either to resize or crop the picture in a photo editing tool. However, when you resize a picture, you may distort the image and if you crop it, you may lose details in the photo. So, to deal with that you can simply resize the canvas. Here's how to do it.

The first round of the square is complete. For round two start by simply chaining three stitches straight up. Double crochet into the large hole near the base of the 'chain three'. Double crochet again into the same hole.

Crochet one more single crochet to make a total of four single crochets. The fourth single crochet counts as the separator between the next cluster. Crochet a double crochet into the corner. Repeat the double crochet two more times to complete the first cluster of round two.

To tie a square knot, start by a rope in each hand. Then, cross the right rope over the left rope in a simple knot. Finish the square knot by tying the rope that's now in your left hand over the rope in your right hand. Pull the knot tight, and voila!
